STAGING PLAN

Stage 1 - Licensees with on-site retail sales

- Pursue Emblem and health permits for retail only
- Pursue Emblem and health permits for all activities
- Three regions for initial roll out
- Phase 1 is voluntary, but Licensees will need to secure required health permits to renew Temporary Approval/Annual License for calendar year 2024

Stage 2 - All Licensees and Applicants with Local Compliance Underway (LCU) by June 30, 2022

All commercial cannabis activities

Stage 3 - New Applicants and Applicants with LCU on or after July 1, 2022



GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL FACILITIES

- · Building is vermin proofed
- Wall-mounted soap & paper towel dispensers (or air hand dryers) for all handwashing sinks
- All equipment and plumbing fixtures approved in good repair
- Adequate ventilation/lighting/shelving
- Approved floors/walls/ceilings/cove base finishes in toilet room
- Cannabis waste area/container secured

CRITICAL ITEMS	NON-CRITICIAL ITEMS
Essential sinks are available	Inoperative lights
 Hot & cold water available at essential sinks 	 Missing paper towel/soap dispensers
Approved water heater	 Broken/missing floor tiles
Toilet available	Peeling paint on walls
 Approved closed loop extraction 	Inadequate storage shelves




SITE EVALUATION PROCESS


- 1. Verify requirements for critical items are met
- 2. Complete application (available online)
- 3. Submit completed application to CCEP at ccep@ph.lacounty.gov (\$334 per activity). We are focusing on storefront retailers first.
- 4. Application reviewed within 7 business days
- 5. Applicant will be contacted and sent invoice
- 6. Either mail in both invoice and payment to CCEP or pay in person at Baldwin Park headquarters

SITE EVALUATION RESULTS: PASS

- Eligible to apply for PHP
- Application for an annual PHP will be issued via email or a hard copy can be provided at the end of site evaluation.
- CCEP will process your application and will provide invoice once it's available from Permit & Licensing Unit.
- PHP fees will depend on the square footage of facility.



SITE EVALUATION RESULTS: PASS

Licensees that pass a site evaluation may apply for Public Health Permit (PHP) and submit an application for an annual PHP. CCEP will process your application and will provide invoice once it's available from Permit & Licensing Unit.

- 3 ways to pay the invoice:
- Bring invoice with payment to our BP HQ
- US Mail both invoice and payment to CCEP
- Pay invoice online by E-Check or credit card



SITE EVALUATION RESULTS: NOT PASS

Plan submission is required to obtain a PHP



Routine Inspections

- Two weeks after payment of PHP
- Unannounced inspections
- Walk through with onsite manager
- Issue Cannabis Inspection Report

Let's Talk About Cannabis

GENERAL INFORMATION

Health Permits and Inspections:

Only dispensaries in Los Angeles County displaying the County Cannabis Emblem are permitted and regulated by the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health (Public Health). To confirm that this is dispensary is permitted by Public Health, call 626-430-5635.

Adult Use (without Medical Recommendation): Adults ages 21 and older in California may possess up to 1 ounce (28.5 grams) of dried cannabis flower and 8 grams of cannabis concentrate. They may also grow up to six plants for personal use.

Medical Marijuana Identification Card (MMIC): In California, individuals age 18 and over with certain medical conditions may apply for an MMIC. Retail purchases of medical cannabis products with an MMIC are exempt from

state and local sales taxes and some local excise taxes, depending on the city.

Laws Restricting Use: Cannabis remains illegal under federal law, so it is illegal to travel across state lines with cannabis even if the state you are traveling to/from allows cannabis use. Your medical cannabis recommendation may be invalid outside of the state in which you obtained it.

- DO NOT onsume cannabis products in public places or anywhere tobacco smoking is prohibited. Landlords may ban cannabis use on their privately-owned rental properties, and employers may ban cannabis use by employees while at work.
- . DO NOT connsume cannabis while riding in or driving a vehicle or boat.
- DO NOT have an open container of cannabis while riding in or driving a vehicle or boat.



Onset and Duration of Effects: Cannabis products affect everyone differently and effects may depend on how cannabis is consumed, how much is consumed, and the user's body composition, among other factors. The effects of smoking/vaping/dabbing cannabis can be felt in seconds to minutes and can last for several hours. The effects of eating/drinking cannabis products can take 30 minutes to 2 hours to be felt and can last up to 8 hours.

Dosage: If you choose to use cannabis, always start with a small dose - 5 mg of tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) for edibles and one pulf/hit if smoking/vaping/dabbing. Then wait 5-10 minutes if smoking/vaping/dabbing, or 2 hours if consuming edibles, to see how you react. Overconsumption of cannabis products can lead to severely distressing psychoactive effects. Cannabis concentrates used for vaping and dabbing can have particularly high concentrations of THC (3 to 10 times higher than smokable flower) and should be used with extreme caution. Edibles should also be used cautiously and in small amounts as they can take up to 2 hours to produce effects.
