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Understanding the Public Convenience or Necessity Process (PCN)



The Los Angeles Municipal Code limits the number of Storefront Retailer Commercial Cannabis Activity Licenses (Types 10 or 12) the Department of Cannabis Regulation (DCR) may issue by Community Plan Area based on the definition of "Undue Concentration" in LAMC Section 104.01(a).

Understanding the Public Convenience or Necessity Process (PCN) cont.



Once DCR has issued a specific number of Type 10 or 12 Licenses in a particular Community Plan Area, Undue Concentration is reached and the City Council must authorize DCR to process additional Type 10 or 12 Applications in that Community Plan Area. The Public Convenience or Necessity Process (PCN) provides the City Council an opportunity to make a PCN finding which provides DCR authorization to process an Application.

Understanding the Public Convenience or Necessity Process (PCN) cont.



Under Section 104.03 of Article 4, Chapter X of the Los Angeles Municipal Code:

The cannabis Public Convenience or Necessity Process allows prospective Social Equity Individual Applicants (SEIAs) to request a finding from City Council that the license would serve the "public convenience or necessity" to be permitted to apply for a retail storefront commercial cannabis license in a Community Plan Area subject to a finding of Undue Concentration.




Step 7b - Pre-Application Request pg. 2b CANNABIS





August 15, 2023 will start a two-week filing period in which DCR will accept PCN requests.

All applications, files, and supporting documents must be submitted by 11:59 PM on Tuesday, August 29th.

Anticipated PCN Timeline and Key Dates



- Pre-Application Record filing period opens
 - Tuesday, August 15, 2023 to Tuesday, August 29, 2023 (11:59 P.M. local time)
- August 30, 2023 Issue Pre-Application Record Invoices (\$597)
 - Due on or before Friday, September 29, 2023
- October 2, 2023 Issue PCN Invoices (\$1,592)
 - Due on or before Wednesday, November 1, 2023
- November 13, 2023 Transmit filed PCN request to the City Clerk
- February 11, 2024 Last Day for City Council to adopt PCN finding

Council Action





Notification of PCN Request

The City Clerk receives PCN request and assigns a Council File Number

Consider item within 90 days

Council has 90 days to review and take action on each PCN request. This discretionary action is made after reviewing the location, need, and surrounding land uses

Issue Decision

If PCN application is denied, the City Clerk notifies DCR, and a communication is triggered to applicant. If PCN is approved, DCR issues an invoice for Application review
