

SAFE CANNABIS POSSESSION AND USE IN L.A.

for consumers





Adults 21 and older may purchase up to 1 ounce of cannabis flower or bud, or up to 8 grams of concentrated cannabis. Adults 18 and older with an LA County Medical Marijuana Identification Card may purchase medical cannabis and possess no more than 8 oz. of cannabis flower or bud per qualified patient.

You cannot use cannabis within 1,000 feet of a school, day care center, or youth center.





Adults 21 and older or adults 18 years or older with a physician's recommendation and Medical Marijuana Identification Card, may plant, harvest, dry, and process up to 6 cannabis plants inside of a private residence or on the grounds of private property.

If you choose to consume cannabis, start slow as some products have a delayed effect of 1-2 hours.

Do not use cannabis while driving; it impairs your judgment and is illegal.



Avoid consuming alcohol and cannabis together.





Do not consume cannabis in public spaces such as beaches or parks.
