

SELF ASSESMENT CHECKLIST

INTRODUCTION

In accordance with Regulation No. 4(D), the Department of Cannabis Regulation (DCR) will conduct a compliance inspection of your Business Premises. This checklist outlines each of the items DCR will inspect to verify compliance with the listed regulations. If issues are identified, you will receive a notice detailing any violations and corrective actions that are required, which may include fines for non-compliance. **As a courtesy**, prior to the inspection, DCR strongly recommends you to go through this self-assessment checklist to identify and rectify any deficiencies. This form is provided to inform you about some of what DCR will inspect, aid DCR with compliance efforts, and mitigate any potential fines you may be given. This form is provided as a courtesy and any self-inspection is optional. You are not required to complete the checklist and it does not need to be returned to DCR.

Most deficiencies may be handled by the issuance of a Notice to Correct which carries no penalties on the outset; however, a Notice to Correct will set a deadline for compliance. If compliance is not met by the deadline, DCR may issue a Notice of Violation (NOV) which includes fines for non-compliance. Use this form to estimate the amount of non-compliance fines associated with a potential NOV that will otherwise be charged by DCR if corrective actions are not taken.

Enter a "1" in the color-shaded column each time you encounter a potential violation. Each Violation Type (VT) is color-coded in this checklist. Minor Violations are **yellow**, Moderate are **orange**, and Major Violations are **red**. Count the violations of each color. Multiply the total **Minor** VTs by \$7,006, **Moderate** VTs by \$21,013, and **Major** VTs by \$42,026. Add these three amounts for the total fines that would be assessed.

3.	Have you installed a security alarm system that notifies you of incidents and records when physical barriers have been breached? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(B) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
4.	Have you implemented an identification and sign-in/sign-out procedure for authorized personnel, individuals, suppliers, and visitors? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(C) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
5.	Are your business premises maintained such that visibility and security monitoring of the entire premises is possible? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(D) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
6.	Have you established procedures for the investigation of suspicious activities and to deter theft or loss of Cannabis and Cannabis Goods? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(E) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
7.	Have you established an inventory system to track Cannabis and Cannabis Goods and the personnel responsible for processing it throughout the manufacturing process? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(E)(i) (Violation Type - Moderate)


8.	Have you established a policy to limit access of personnel within your business premises to those areas necessary to complete job duties, and to those time frames specifically scheduled for completion of job duties? Have you established a policy to limit access to your business premises by outside vendors, suppliers, contractors or other individuals conducting business with the licensee that requires access to the premises? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(E)(ii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
9.	Have you established a policy to supervise tasks or processes with high potential for diversion? How do you supervise or process the loading and unloading of Cannabis and Cannabis Goods from transportation vehicles? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(E)(iii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
10.	Do you provide areas on your business premises where personnel may store and access personal items that are separate from manufacturing areas? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(E)(iv) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
11.	Do you secure and back up electronic records in a manner that prevents unauthorized access and ensures that the integrity of the records is maintained? Regulation 5(A)(4)(iii)(F) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
12.	Are you <i>only</i> using the name of your licensed business entity and/or business premises location (whichever is applicable) for the submission of <i>all</i> permits, certificates, and/or documents issued by the City of Los Angeles, County, and/or State of California? Regulation 5(A)(1)(vi) (Violation Type - Major)	
13.	Do you <i>only</i> market or advertise the commercial cannabis activity(ies) for which you possess a license or temporary approval? Does your marketing and/or advertising make deceptive, false or misleading statements on any advertisement, website, product, sign, or any document provided to a customer? *Regulation 5(A)(1)(xi) (Violation Type - Moderate)



1.	Are you complying with all the requirements of Cal. Code Regs., tit. 4, § 15420, for delivery request receipts? Regulation 5(D)(4) (Violation Type - Minor)	
2.	Are all deliveries of cannabis and cannabis goods by your business performed by your own employees? Are all of your employees who deliver Cannabis and/or Cannabis goods at least 21 years of age? Do your deliveries and delivery employees comply with all the requirements specified in Regulation 5(D)(1)? Regulation 5(D)(1) (Violation Type - Major)	
3.	Can you provide a copy of the specifications of the age verification device or devices that are used by delivery employees and meet the requirements specified in Regulation 5(D)(5) to DCR? Regulation 5(D)(5) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
4	Have you registered all motor vehicles used for the delivery of cannabis and cannabis goods with DCR, including all the information specified in Regulation 5(D)(11)? Do all of your active delivery vehicles have a DVP and meet the requirements of Regulation 5(D)(11)? Regulation 5(D)(11) (Violation Type - Moderate)	






1.	When prompted, are DCR employees with City identification given unrestricted access to your business premises during regular business hours? Regulation 5(A)(1)(iv) (Violation Type - Major)	
2.	When prompted, will you provide DCR with full cooperation for all compliance determinations including, but not limited to, providing DCR with all information, surveillance recordings, and/or any other data in the form, manner, and time requested? Regulation 5(A)(1)(iii) (Violation Type - Major)	
3.	Is there any graffiti on all property under your control, including all adjacent areas, such as the parking lot, adjoining sidewalk or alley? All graffiti must be removed or painted over to match the color of the surface within 72 hours of its occurrence. Regulation 5(A)(2)(v) (Violation Type - Minor)	
4.	Is all property under your control, including all adjacent areas, such as the parking lot, adjoining sidewalk or alley, maintained in an attractive condition and kept free of obstruction, trash, litter, and debris at all times? Regulation 5(A)(2)(v) (Violation Type - Minor)	
5.	Is your business properly ventilated? Is all exhaust air filtered to neutralize the odor from cannabis so that it cannot be detected on the exterior of your business premises? Operable windows or vents shall not abut a residential use or zone and shall direct exhaust away from residential areas. Regulation 5(A)(5)(i) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
6.	Are all exterior portions of your business premises adequately illuminated beginning at dusk so as to make discernible the faces and clothing of persons utilizing the space during evening hours? Are all outdoor lights used for safety and security purposes shielded and downward facing? Regulation 5(A)(5)(ii) (Violation Type - Minor)

7.	Is all the rooftop equipment on your business premises, including air conditioning units, ventilation and mechanical equipment, screened from view of the public? Regulation 5(A)(5)(iii) (Violation Type - Minor).	
8.	Are "No Loitering, Public Drinking, or Public Smoking/ Consumption of Cannabis" signs clearly posted inside and outside of your business premises? Loitering is prohibited on or around your business premises and all areas under your control. Regulation 5(A)(6)(iv) (Violation Type - Minor)	
9.	Is your business premises in compliance with Regulation 5(A)(6)(vi)? Outdoor speakers and/or paging systems are not allowed on the exterior portions of your business premises, or attached to the façade of the building. Regulation 5(A)(6)(vi) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
10.	Is your business premises in compliance with Regulation 5(C)(12)(vi)? Outdoor speakers and/or paging systems are not allowed on the exterior portions of your business premises, or attached to the façade of the building. Regulation 5(C)(12)(v) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
11.	Are any and all City of Los Angeles licenses, State licenses, BTRCs, Emblem Placards, emergency information, and information for your designated Neighborhood Liaison, including their phone number and email address to receive complaints prominently displayed on your business premises? Are all relevant displays in compliance with Regulation 5(A)(2)(i)? Regulation 5(A)(2)(i) (Violation Type - Minor)	
12.	Have you obtained a Health Permit and Emblem Placard (retailers only) from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health? Have you posted the Emblem Placard as required under LAMC Section 104.23? Note: this will be a requirement starting January 1, 2025 Regulation 5(C)(13) (Violation Type - Moderate)

Video Surveillance

1.	Does your surveillance system clearly record images within 20 feet of all points of entry and exits on your business premises from both indoor and outdoor vantage points at all times? Are your cameras permanently mounted and in a fixed location? Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(A) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
2.	Does your surveillance system record areas that include, but are not limited to: (a) areas where Cannabis Goods are weighed, packed, stored, loaded and unloaded for transportation, prepared, or moved within your business premises; (b) limited-access Areas; (c) security rooms; and (d) areas storing a surveillance-system device with at least one camera recording the access points to the area? Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(A) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
3.	Do you record all point-of-sale areas and areas where cannabis and cannabis goods are displayed for sale? At each point of sale location, camera placement must allow for the recording of the facial features of any person purchasing and selling cannabis or cannabis goods, and any person in the retail area. Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(B) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
4.	Do you secure the physical media and/or all storage devices on which surveillance recordings are stored in a manner to protect against tampering or theft for a minimum of 90 days? Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(C) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
5.	Is your video surveillance system kept in a manner which allows recordings of your business premises to be viewed and/or copies to be obtained immediately upon request by the City? Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(D) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
6.	Does your video surveillance system record continuously, 24 hours per day and at a minimum of 15 frames per second (FPS)? Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(C) (Violation Type - Moderate)	

Video Surveillance

7.	Does your video surveillance system record images clearly and accurately and display the time and date? Time is to be measured in seconds, minutes and hours using Pacific Standard Time. Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(C) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
8.	Is your video surveillance system equipped with a failure notification feature that provides you with notification of any interruption or failure of the equipment or its storage? Regulation 5(A)(4)(i)(C) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
9.	Are your business premises equipped with a surveillance system with a minimum camera resolution of 1280 × 720 pixels? Regulation 5(A)(4)(i) (VT – Moderate)	



Business Premises Diagram


1.	Have your business premises been physically changed, altered, or modified from what was originally filed with your original application? If yes, did DCR provide written approval prior to any changes being made? Regulation 5(A)(3)(i) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
2.	Has any portion of your business premises been sublet without written approval from the DCR? Regulation 5(A)(6)(i) (Violation Type - Major)	
3.	Are all doors not intended for customer access kept closed at all times other than to permit access for deliveries and trash removal? Are all exterior doors solid and not a screen or ventilated security door? Regulation 5(C)(11) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
4.	Are all limited-access areas and all points of entry and exit to your business premises equipped with commercial-grade, nonresidential door locks in accordance with the approved security plan? Regulation 5(A)(4)(v) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
5.	Do you only permit authorized individuals who are at least 21 years of age to enter limited-access areas on your business premises? Authorized individuals include: your employees, outside vendors, contractors or other individuals conducting business that requires access to the limited-access Area. Regulation 5(A)(4)(vi) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
6.	Do your employees escort all non-employees within any limited-access area on your business premises at all times? Regulation 5(A)(4)(vi) (Violation Type - Moderate)

7.

Do you maintain a log which tracks non-employee access to limited-access areas on your business premises? This log must be provided to DCR upon request. Licensees shall not receive consideration or compensation for permitting an individual to enter a Limited-Access Area.

Security Requirements


1.	(For Retail) Have you hired or contracted security personnel licensed by the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services to provide security services for your business premises during operating hours? Are all security personnel at least 21 years of age? Regulation 5(A)(4)(ii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
2.	Are you maintaining an alarm system as required by the State? Did a licensed alarm company operator or one of its registered alarm agents install the alarm system? Did a licensed alarm company operator or one of its registered alarm agents maintain, monitor, and respond to the alarm system? Upon request, can you make available to the City all information related to the alarm system, monitoring, and alarm activity. Have you applied for, and/or do you maintain in good standing, an Alarm System Permit issued pursuant to LAMC Section 103.206. Regulation 5(A)(4)(iv) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
3.	Do all agents, officers, or other persons acting for or employed by you display an identification badge at all times while conducting business operations? Regulation 5(A)(2)(ii) (Violation Type - Minor)	
4.	Do your agents, officers, or other persons acting for or employed by you identification badges include: (1) your business entity name or DBA, (2) your DCR record number, (3) the employee's first name, (4) an employee number exclusively assigned to that employee for identification purposes, and (5) a color photograph of the employee that clearly shows the full front of the employee's face and that is at least 1 inch in width and 1.5 inches in height? Regulation 5(A)(2)(ii) (Violation Type - Minor)	
5.	Any time your store is not open for retail sales, do you ensure your business premises are securely locked with commercial-grade, non-residential door locks? Regulation 5(C)(4)(i) (Violation Type – Moderate)	
6.	Any time your store is not open for retail sales, do you ensure your business premises are equipped with an active alarm system? Regulation 5(C)(4)(ii) (Violation Type – Moderate)

Any time your store is not open for retail sales, do you ensure only your authorized employees and contractors are allowed to enter your business premises after hours?

1.	Are you and/or your employees physically present in the retail area whenever non-employees are in the retail area? Regulation 5(C)(3) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
2.	Does your business only display cannabis and/or cannabis goods in your retail area? Regulation 5(C)(5)(i) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
3.	Does your business remove cannabis and cannabis goods from their packaging and place them in containers to allow for customer inspection? Are these containers only accessible to customers with the assistance of your personnel? Containers must be provided to customers by retailers who shall remain with the customer at all times. Regulation 5(C)(5)(ii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
4.	Do you destroy all cannabis and cannabis goods that have been removed from their packaging for display, when no longer used for display, pursuant to State requirements? Regulation 5(C)(5)(iii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
5.	Do you refrain from providing free samples of cannabis or cannabis goods? Do you prohibit representatives of other companies or organizations from providing free samples of any type, including cannabis or cannabis goods, on your business premises. Regulation 5(C)(7) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
6.	Do you place all cannabis and/or cannabis goods purchased by customers in an exit package before they leave your business premises, as required by the State? Regulation 5(C)(8) (Violation Type - Moderate)

7.	Do you use an electronic age verification device at each point-of-sales area to determine the age of anyone attempting to purchase cannabis or cannabis goods on your business premises? Is your electronic age verification device maintained in operational condition and have all of your employees been instructed on its use? Does your business use your functioning electronic age verification device for all cannabis and cannabis goods sold to the public? Regulation 5(C)(10) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
8.	Does your business conduct prohibited activities such as sales through drive through windows or walk-up windows? Regulation 5(C)(12)(i) (Violation Type - Major)	
9.	Does your business conduct prohibited activities such as providing adult entertainment of any type, as defined in LAMC Section 12.70, or alcohol or tobacco sales of any type on your business premises? Regulation 5(C)(12)(ii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
10.	Does your business conduct prohibited activities such as providing entertainment of any type, except for ambient music. Disc jockeys, karaoke, and/or performances of any kind are prohibited. Does all music, sound, or noise emitted from your business premises comply with the noise regulations of the LAMC and not extend beyond your business premises? Regulation 5(C)(12)(iii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
11.	Does your business conduct prohibited activities such as providing pool or billiard tables, dart games, video games, coin operated game machines or similar game devices on your business premises? Regulation 5(C)(12)(iv) (Violation Type - Minor)

Do you keep and maintain training records, including, but not limited to, the date and content and date of the training provided, the names of the Persons who administered the training, and the names of the employees that received the training for at least seven years? Regulation 5(B)(1)(i)(C) (Violation Type - Minor)	
6.	Do you keep and maintain contracts with other Licensees for at least seven years? Regulation 5(B)(1)(i)(D) (Violation Type - Minor)

	Will you notify (or, if applicable, have you notified) DCR, in writing, of any criminal conviction entered against your Licensee or Applicant, any Owner of the Licensee or Applicant, any Primary Personnel of the Licensee or Applicant, or Management Company of the Licensee or Applicant, by electronic mail within 48 hours of the entry of the conviction?

Will you notify (or, if applicable, have you notified) DCR, in writing, of any judgment or civil penalty entered against the Licensee or Applicant, any Owner of the Licensee or Applicant, any Primary Personnel of the Licensee or Applicant, or Management Company of the Licensee or Applicant, by electronic mail within 48 hours of the date of service of the verdict or the notice of entry of judgment, whichever is sooner? Have you provided written notice to DCR of the revocation or suspension of any State license, or other permit, clearance or authorization from any public agency within 48 hours of such revocation or suspension?



12.	Will you notify (or, if applicable, have you notified) DCR of any suspected or actual diversion, theft, loss, or any other criminal activity pertaining to the operation of your business within 24 hours of discovery? Regulation 5(A)(7)(ii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
13.	Will you notify (or, if applicable, have you notified) DCR of any suspected or actual diversion, theft, loss, or any other criminal activity by an agent or employee pertaining to the operation of your business within 24 hours of discovery? Regulation 5(A)(7)(ii) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
14.	Will you notify (or, if applicable, have you notified) DCR the loss or unauthorized alteration of records related to cannabis, cannabis goods, registered medical cannabis patients or primary caregivers, or employees or agents within 24 hours of discovery? 


1.	Are all deliveries of cannabis and cannabis goods by your business performed by your own employees? Are all of your employees who deliver Cannabis and/or Cannabis goods at least 21 years of age? Do your deliveries and delivery employees comply with all the requirements specified in Regulation 5(D)(1)? Regulation 5(D)(1) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
2.	Do all of your delivery employees have an identification badge and display it at all times while conducting delivery business operations? Does the identification badge include: your business entity name or DBA, DCR record number, the employee's name, an employee number exclusively assigned to that employee for identification purposes, and a color photograph of the employee that clearly shows the full front of the employee's face and is at least 1 inch in width and 1.5 inches in height? Regulation 5(D)(1) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
3.	Are all of your deliveries of cannabis and cannabis goods made in person? Does every vehicle used to deliver your business' cannabis and cannabis goods not contain any external markings, words, or symbols that indicate the vehicle is used for delivery of cannabis or cannabis goods or that the vehicle is used, owned or leased by a cannabis licensee? Regulation 5(D)(2) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
4.	Do you utilize an electronic age verification to determine the age of any individual attempting to purchase cannabis or cannabis goods for delivery? Do you utilize an electronic age verification at the point-of-sale(s) and at the point of delivery? Have all of your employees been instructed in its use? Did you provide a copy of the specifications of the age verification device or devices used by your delivery employees to DCR within 30 days of receiving a delivery license but prior to any delivery of cannabis or cannabis goods? Regulation 5(D)(5) (Violation Type - Moderate)	
5.	Do all of your employees who carry cannabis or cannabis goods for delivery operate and travel only in an enclosed motor vehicle? Do your employees restrict visibility of all cannabis and cannabis goods from the public during delivery and transport? Regulation 5(D)(6) (Violation Type - Major)	

6.	Do all of your delivery employees refrain from leaving cannabis or cannabis goods in an unattended motor vehicle unless the motor vehicle is locked and equipped with an active vehicle alarm system? Have you equipped all of your vehicles used for delivery of cannabis and cannabis goods with a Global Positioning System (GPS) device which can identify the geographic location of the delivery vehicle during business hours? Note: A personal or business phone or tablet is not an acceptable GPS device. Do you	
	immediately share GPS information with the City upon request? Is the GPS device permanently or temporarily affixed to the delivery vehicle and remains active and inside of the delivery vehicle during business hours?
