Members of the public are invited to address the Cannabis Regulation Commission, in person, on any item(s) on the agenda during Single or Multiple Agenda Item-Public Comment, prior to action by the Commission on the specific item(s). Members of the public may also address the Commission on any matter within the jurisdiction of the Commission during General Public Comment. To participate and offer public testimony in person during a meeting, an individual must complete and submit a speaker's request form to the Commission Executive Assistant prior to the start of the applicable public comment period.

An individual shall be limited to one (1) minute of public comment per agenda item, up to two (2) minutes per meeting. In total, an individual shall be limited to two (2) minutes of public comment in this special meeting. The Commission may limit the total amount of time for public comment on any specific agenda item and/or on all agenda items collectively based on the anticipated time required to hear from public speakers on any given or all agenda items, on the availability of Commission members and the need to maintain quorum, and on any other relevant factor.

The Commission may break for mealtime at approximately 6:30 pm. Any agenda items not acted upon during the pre-mealtime session will be considered afterwards. TIME SEGMENTS noted * herein are approximate. Some items may be delayed due to the length of discussion of previous items.

The Commission may RECONSIDER and alter its action taken on items listed herein at any time during this meeting or during the next regular meeting, in accordance with the Commission's Rules and Operating Procedures and provided that the Commission retains jurisdiction over the item. In the case of a Commission meeting cancellation, all items shall be continued to the next regular meeting date or beyond, as long as the continuance is within the legal time limits of the item.

Submission of materials to the Commission:

- **Day-of hearing submissions.** All submissions within 48-hours of the Commission meeting up to and including the day of the meeting must be a hard copy submission. Electronic submissions will not be accepted within this time period. Day-of submissions may not be more than two (2) single-sided pages, including exhibits, and must include the agenda item number on the cover or first page. Photographs do not count toward the page limitation. Twelve (12) copies of the submission must be given to the Commission Executive Assistant prior to the start of the meeting. The materials will be distributed to the Commission and will be available to the public.
- **Non-Complying Submissions.** Submissions that do not comply with these rules will be marked or stamped “**File Copy. Non-complying Submission.**” Non-complying submissions will be placed into the official case file, but they will not be delivered to or considered by the Commission, and will not be included in the official administrative record for the item at issue.

If you challenge these agenda items in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing agenzized here, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to this body at or prior to the public hearing. If you seek judicial review of any decision of the City pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.5, the petition for writ of mandate pursuant to that section must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which the City's decision became final pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6. There may be other time limits which also affect your ability to seek judicial review.

Sign language interpreters, language interpreters, assistive listening devices, or other auxiliary aids and/or other services may be provided upon request. 4. PRESENTATIONS RE CANNABIS TAXATION FROM CANNABIS APPLICANTS, LICENSEES, AND/OR CANNABIS TRADE ASSOCIATIONS

The Commission will hear presentations from the public in accordance with the following rules:

- The Commission shall hear presentations from the Department's Commercial Cannabis Applicants and Licensees, or cannabis trade associations, for up to six hours not including breaks.
- **Presentations shall be limited to the issue of cannabis taxation only.**
- For Applicants and Licensees, only the following individuals are authorized to make a presentation to the Commission:
 - (1) Owners, Primary Personnel, or Authorized Agents as defined in LAMC section 104.01(a), and as listed on an Application or License record in the DCR Licensing Portal; or
 - (2) An individual who brings a letter that appoints them as the designated representative of an Applicant or Licensee for the purposes of the Commission hearing, where the letter is on official letterhead for an Applicant or Licensee and is signed by at least one of the Owner(s), Primary Personnel, or Authorized Agent(s) listed on the record.
- For cannabis trade associations, a representative must be designated in a letter that appoints them as the designated representative for the purposes of the Commission hearing, and which is on official letterhead for that trade association.
- Individual presentations will be limited to 15 minutes each and may, at the discretion of the Commission, be followed by a period of questions from the Commission for up to 15 additional minutes. No individual presentation, including the Commission question period, shall exceed 30 minutes. **No individual shall be permitted to cede any portion of their presentation time to another individual.**

How to sign up to make a presentation:

- Beginning one hour before the scheduled start of the meeting, a designated area will be available in front of Council Chambers for those who wish to make a presentation to form a single line.
- Commission staff will write down the names of all individuals in the order they are standing in line on a numbered sheet ("Presentation List"). All individuals must provide to Commission staff: (1) their name; (2) the name of the Applicant, Licensee, or cannabis trade association on whose behalf they are speaking on; and (3) a copy of a letter that authorizes them to speak on behalf of an Applicant, Licensee, or trade association. The Presentation List will be provided to the Commission Chair. Individuals do not have to remain in line after their name has been placed on the list. The list will close 15 minutes before the Commission meeting begins.
- Only those individuals on the Presentation List will be permitted to present digital visual aid materials to the Commission. Permitted file formats that will be accepted are Portable Document Format (.pdf), PowerPoint (.ppt) or Google Slides slides. Alternatively, hard copies of a slide deck can be submitted for distribution to the Commission. Six (6) copies must be provided to the Commission Executive Assistant prior to the start of the meeting.
- For electronic files, presenters must email their files to CannabisCommission@lacity.org at the time their name is added to the Presentation List. Presenters must include their assigned Presentation List number in the subject line of their email. Alternatively, presenters may bring at least eight printed copies of the presentation for distribution. **External storage devices, such as a thumb drive, will not be accepted.**
- Council Chambers will be opened approximately 15 minutes before the Commission meeting begins.
- When this agenda item is called, the Commission Chair will call speakers in the order they appear on the Presentation List.

Additional notes:

- Individuals on the Presentation List may invite additional people to participate in their presentation and share their presentation time; however, the total time allowed for the entire presentation shall not exceed 15 minutes, regardless of the number of speakers. Only one digital file will be permitted per presentation, regardless of the number of speakers.
- Only those individuals who are on the Presentation List will be permitted to submit digital presentations.
- **If an individual is not present when their name is called by the Commission Chair, their turn will be forfeited and the next individual will be called to the podium; they will not be re-called later in the Commission meeting.**
- **If the individual is not an Applicant or a Licensee, or does not have an appointing letter designating them as a representative of an Applicant, Licensee or trade association, they will not be allowed to make a presentation.**
